

Chevron Extended Warranty Agriculture



Chevron Products Company, a division of Chevron U.S.A. Inc., offers the following extended warranty for owners of eligible agricultural equipment upon the conditions and limitations set forth below:

APPLICATION

An owner of eligible equipment that desires the protection of the Chevron Extended Warranty - Agriculture ("Warranty") must submit the following (collectively the "Application"), to your Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager from whom the owner purchases the applicable lubricants and coolants described below as "Applicable Chevron Products":

- (1) A Chevron Extended Warranty Registration form for the type of equipment to be covered; and
- (2) Chevron Extended Warranty Agreement form; and
- (3) Most recent Oil Drain or Coolant Analysis Report (required when applying for coverage of used equipment).

APPROVAL PROCESS

Chevron will advise the owner by letter as to whether the owner's Application was approved or rejected. CHEVRON RESERVES THE RIGHT, IN ITS SOLE DISCRETION, TO REJECT ANY APPLICATION SUBMITTED FOR APPROVAL.

WARRANTY

Subject to the limitations and exclusions contained herein, Chevron will pay for reasonable labor costs and parts to repair or replace specified lubricated power train or coolant system parts that fail or exhibit abnormal wear during the Warranty term. The Warranty term shall begin on the date of approval of owner's Application and expire nine (9) years from the date of first sale or nine-thousand (9,000) service hours, whichever occurs first. Chevron is not liable for any amount that exceeds the value of the labor and parts covered. Chevron is not liable for any repair amount that exceeds \$25,000 per covered equipment.

ELIGIBLE AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT

Both new and used agricultural equipment still under manufacturer's warranty (rebuilt equipment is not covered).

- Farm Tractors (50hp Minimum): all damage to the listed lubricated power train or coolant system parts of diesel engines, power transmissions, hydraulic pumps and valves, wet brakes and clutch fittings and drive train.
- Other Agricultural Equipment: all damage to the listed lubricated and cooled power train or coolant system parts of diesel engines only.

OBLIGATIONS OF OWNER

1. Proper lubricants and coolants: Owner agrees to use the proper products approved by Chevron, as set forth in the Applicable Chevron Products column in the table above, exclusively in the covered parts covered by the Warranty. Owner must retain dated receipts for purchases of Chevron lubricant or coolant products as well as purchases of oil filters, from the date of registration. The use of additives or unauthorized lubricants or coolants will void the Warranty.
2. Maintenance: Equipment must be used under normal operating conditions and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations, including manufacturer's recommended drain intervals.
3. Chevron's LubeWatch® Oil and Coolant Analysis Program: At every drain, an oil and coolant analysis must be conducted at a Chevron authorized testing facility, with an oil and coolant analysis kit purchased through your Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager. All oil and coolant LubeWatch records must be retained.
4. Corrective Action: Owner agrees to abide by all the requirements of and recommendations provided under Chevron's LubeWatch® Oil and Coolant Analysis Program.
5. Modification: Owner will not modify the Equipment, either during the manufacturer's warranty period or the Chevron Warranty period, unless approved the manufacturer or your Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager.

CLAIM PROCESS

Owner must notify their Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager upon experiencing equipment failure or damage related to covered parts. This notification must be received within 30 calendar days from the date of the equipment failure or damage. Owner shall provide information such as the Warranty approval number, the number of engine hours, the equipment problem and a repair facility authorized by the equipment manufacturer. The Owner shall submit a sample of used oil or coolant from the damaged equipment, a sample of fresh oil or coolant from which the used oil or coolant originated (if available from a bulk supply source), and the damaged parts to a Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager. Upon request, the owner shall also submit all equipment maintenance records (including proof of Chevron product purchase and LubeWatch analysis). Chevron will contact the authorized repair facility to review the problem and necessary repairs. Prior written authorization from Chevron for the proposed repairs must be received through Chevron Marketer or Lubrication Business Manager if the repairs are to be covered by the Warranty. Upon completion of repairs and verification of repair costs, Chevron will send owner a check in the amount necessary to cover the cost of the covered parts and reasonable labor costs to replace them.

ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS

In addition to previously listed limitations to the Warranty, Warranty coverage does not extend to (a) repairs covered under OEM warranty or other applicable warranties or insurance, (b) costs to replace or repair non-lubricated or coolant parts, (c) costs of repairs that are faulty, improperly performed or violated the manufacturer's warranty or legal regulations, (d) costs of repairs for damages sustained prior to Chevron approving participant's registration, (e) costs of routine equipment maintenance and/or inspections, whether required by manufacturer or otherwise, (f) costs submitted by persons who, in making a claim, submit false, inaccurate and/or incomplete information, (g) rebuilt, custom-built and/or custom-engineered equipment, (h) more than one repair to any specific part during the life of the warranty, and (i) damages sustained due to equipment abuse, accident, casualty loss, negligence, alteration, or manufactured design flaws or improper installation. Additionally, for 50+ Horsepower Farm Tractors, Warranty coverage does not extend to (a) any failures of Covered Parts caused by dirt, water or other foreign matter entering the hydraulic system, (b) any attached ancillary equipment, including hydraulic pumps, lines or cylinders on implements. Also, for diesel engines, Warranty coverage does not extend to engine block, cylinder head assembly, valves, oil pump, turbo chargers, oil consumption unrelated to oil quality, and repairs resulting from coolant leaks.

DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTY

THE FOREGOING WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

LIMITATIONS OF REMEDIES

As to remedies available to owner for any and all losses or damages, including losses or damages arising from a claim of breach of warranty, breach of contract, negligence or strict liability, owner's exclusive remedy shall be limited to the replacement value of the failed internal part or parts of the equipment covered by this Warranty. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL CHEVRON BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES BASED UPON ANY LEGAL THEORY, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LOST PROFITS, LOSS OF EQUIPMENT, COST OF ANY SUBSTITUTE EQUIPMENT, DOWNTIME, COST OF HAULING AND COST OF LODGING.

TRANSFER OF WARRANTY

The Chevron Extended Warranty – Agriculture is not transferable to a subsequent purchaser of the covered equipment.
