New for 2021

- Phone number change: call or text (502) 345-1478, or call (800) 501-7469
- Eligible tractors must be model year 1980 or earlier (see page 1 in the Instruction Book for details)
- Coming in 2022, eligible tractors must have been tested by the University of Nebraska Tractor Test Laboratory (NTTL) (see page 24 in the Instruction Book for details)
- Restoration Report requirements (see page 1 in the Instruction Book for details):
 - 100-page length limit
 - Page numbers required
 - Fonts should be easy to read, and a minimum of 10pt
